

Special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Chester was held **January 30, 2013** at 5:30 pm in the Town Municipal Center, Chestertown, NY.

Roll Call: Edna Wells, Frederick H. Monroe, Steve Durkish, and Karen DuRose. Absent was Mike Packer.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss a Sno-Cross event that was being sponsored by Green Mansions Golf Club. They had planned to sponsor it last year, but there was no snow.

Ron Walker and Al Matrose had met with Mr. Monroe, concerned that they might not have any snow, and they had wondered if the Town could dump the snow from street cleanup into Green Mansions. They had also requested use of our snow making equipment, but the Generator that runs the machine belongs to the County, so that will not be loaned. Green Mansions has made other arrangements.

Initially they had asked if we could help pay toward the cost of the insurance, but the board is loathe to do that, as this isn't a "not for profit" organization. Discussion ensued, and the Board decided that they would rather contribute toward the advertising for the event, so that they are given good coverage. Additionally, Supervisor Monroe had spoken with Warrensburg Supervisor Geraghty, and he agreed to offer support from their town, as well, since most of Green Mansions is located within their boundary.

RESOLUTION #18: SUPPORT SNO-CROSS EVENT AT GREEN MANSIONS, TRANSPORT SNOW, AND OFFER MONEY FOR ADVERTISING.

Introduced by Mr. Monroe, seconded by Mrs. DuRose, the Town of Chester will transport snow from street cleaning to Green Mansions instead of behind the Health Center. The Town of Chester also supports the East Coast Sno-Cross event to be sponsored by Green Mansions, and offers to pay \$750 toward the cost of advertising the event, requesting that the Town of Warrensburg do the same.
